WHAT patterns drive political action?

Complex Change . . .


- . . . emerges from tension
- ▶ Tension emerges from difference, connected
- ▶ Difference is fractal—it appears across levels
- ► Each level has the capacity to hold difference, but that capacity isn't unlimited
- When the tension is too great, the pattern shifts and releases energy into the larger system

- Depends on complex world view


